WHY BRICS? WHY NOW?

Understanding the Strategic Importance of BRICS in the 21st Century

The global economic and geopolitical landscape is undergoing a profound transformation. Emerging economies are assuming greater responsibility in shaping international trade, technology, sustainable development, financial cooperation and global governance. At the centre of this transformation stands **BRICS**—an influential grouping of major emerging economies committed to promoting inclusive growth, multilateral cooperation and a more balanced global order.

Originally comprising **Brazil, Russia, India, China** and **South Africa**, **BRICS** has evolved into a broader platform with the inclusion of new member nations, reflecting its growing significance in international affairs. Today, **BRICS** represents a substantial share of the world's population, economic output, natural resources and future growth potential, making it one of the most consequential forums for dialogue among developing and emerging economies.

For **India**, **BRICS** is more than an international partnership—it is a strategic platform to advance national priorities while collaborating with other Global South nations on issues of shared concern. From digital public infrastructure and artificial intelligence to climate resilience, healthcare, trade, innovation and sustainable development, **BRICS** provides opportunities to exchange knowledge, foster innovation and shape policies that address common challenges.

At the same time, India possesses one of the world's greatest strategic advantages—its youth. With over **65%** of the population below the age of 35, young Indians will play a decisive role in determining how the nation responds to rapid technological change, environmental challenges and evolving global economic realities. Yet, despite being the primary stakeholders in tomorrow's world, young people often have limited opportunities to contribute meaningfully to structured policy discourse.

The **National Pragati Dialogue 2026** seeks to bridge this gap by creating a credible platform where informed youth participation translates into actionable policy recommendations. Rather than treating young citizens as passive observers, the initiative recognises them as active contributors to India's developmental journey.

Through rigorous research, committee deliberations, parliamentary debate and expert mentoring, delegates will collaboratively develop the **National Youth Statement on BRICS**—a comprehensive policy document presenting practical, evidence-based recommendations across critical areas including responsible artificial intelligence, climate finance, sustainable manufacturing, renewable energy, women-led innovation, food security, dispute resolution and cultural economy.

This initiative reflects the belief that sustainable policymaking must be participatory, interdisciplinary and forward-looking. By bringing together students, researchers, academicians, legal professionals, civil servants, industry experts and policymakers, the **National Pragati Dialogue** fosters meaningful dialogue that connects academic knowledge with real-world governance challenges.

As India advances towards the vision of **Viksit Bharat 2047**, empowering young citizens to engage with policy is not merely desirable—it is essential. The National Pragati Dialogue therefore serves as a platform where ideas are transformed into informed recommendations, collaboration becomes collective action, and the aspirations of India's youth contribute to shaping both national priorities and the future of **BRICS** cooperation.

THE NATIONAL YOUTH STATEMENT ON BRICS

India's First National Youth Policy Drafting Parliament on BRICS

The National Youth Statement on BRICS is the flagship outcome of the **National Pragati Dialogue 2026**. It is a pioneering youth-led policy initiative that enables participants to contribute directly to the formulation of policy recommendations on issues of strategic importance to India and the BRICS nations.

Unlike a Model United Nations (MUN), a mock parliament, or a conventional youth conference, the National Youth Statement is developed through a **National Policy Drafting Parliament**—a structured legislative drafting exercise inspired by parliamentary committee processes and evidence-based policymaking.

Rather than preparing policy recommendations from scratch during the event, the Drafting Parliament begins with a **Preliminary Draft of the National Youth Statement on BRICS**, developed through months of research and expert consultation by the **Policy Secretariat**.

The preliminary draft is prepared with contributions and guidance from a multidisciplinary network comprising:



Professors and academic mentors from IIT Guwahati, NIT Silchar and Dibrugarh University.



Doctoral Scholars and Researchers from IIT Bombay and Tezpur University.



Advocates associated with the Delhi High Court and the Gauhati High Court, providing expertise in legislative drafting and legal review.



Government officers and public policy practitioners, contributing perspectives from governance and public administration.



Representatives associated with UN-YOUNGO, bringing international insights on sustainable development and youth engagement.



Senior professionals from technology, consulting and industry, ensuring that recommendations remain practical, future-oriented and aligned with contemporary economic and technological realities.

Every registered delegate receives the preliminary draft before the event, enabling meaningful preparation and informed participation.

During the National Policy Drafting Parliament, delegates examine the document clause by clause, following a structured legislative procedure. Participants are empowered to introduce new recommendations, propose amendments, recommend modifications or deletions, and present evidence-based arguments in support of their proposals. Each recommendation is debated by the House and placed before delegates for a majority vote. Amendments approved by the House are incorporated into the working draft, ensuring that the final document reflects both expert research and the collective wisdom of India's youth.

Following the adoption of the Statement by the House, the document is consolidated by the Policy Secretariat and reviewed by the Advisory Board, comprising distinguished academicians, legal experts, government practitioners and industry leaders. The final document is then published in consultation with the BRICS Chamber of Commerce & Industry (BRICS CCI).

The published **National Youth Statement on BRICS** will subsequently be submitted to relevant Ministries of the Government of India, the BRICS Chamber of Commerce & Industry (BRICS CCI), and BRICS diplomatic missions, enabling the policy recommendations developed during the National Pragati Dialogue to contribute to broader institutional and policy conversations.

Every participating delegate whose contribution forms part of the adopted document will be formally recognised as an **Official Co-Author of the National Youth Statement on BRICS**, acknowledging their role in one of India's first structured youth-led national policy drafting initiatives.

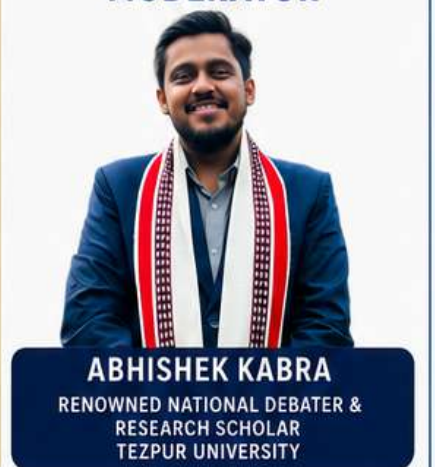
